## NIC NOTES

### Dear Parishioners:

The veiling of statues and images of Christ and the Saints during Passiontide, i.e., the two weeks before Easter, is an ancient Catholic practice which seems puzzling at first sight. Like so many Catholic Parishes, we cover our statues and crucifixes in the Church and Chapel.

### *Historical Background*

Monsignor Elliott remarks, "The custom of veiling crosses and images has much to commend it in terms of religious psychology, because it helps us to concentrate on the great essentials of Christ's work of Redemption." The historical origin of this practice lies elsewhere. It probably derives from a custom, noted in Germany from the ninth century, of extending a large cloth before the altar from the beginning of Lent. This cloth was called the "Hungertuch" (hunger cloth). Some authors say the practical reason for this action was so the often-illiterate faithful had a way to know it was Lent. Others maintain that it was a remnant of the ancient practice of public penance in which the penitents were ritually expelled from the Church at the beginning of Lent. Prior to the revision of the Roman Missal in 1970, crosses and images were covered with veils during Passiontide which is the last two weeks of Lent, starting from the end of the Mass for Saturday of the Fourth Week of Lent. Since 1970, in the United States, the practice of veiling crosses and statues was not allowed since the USCCB had not voted on the issue. With the revision of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), the USCCB, in 2001, approved adaptations for the United States.

### *The Mystical Interpretation*

Abbot Gueranger enlightens us with a mystical/spiritual interpretation of the Gospel: As Christ hid Himself from the Jewish authorities, so now He is hidden from the world in preparation for the mysteries of His passion. "The presentiment of that awful hour [of our Savior's Passion] leads the Afflicted Mother [the Church] to veil the image of her Jesus: the cross is hidden from the eyes of the faithful. The statues of the saints, too, are covered; for it is just that, if the glory of the Master be eclipsed, the servant should not appear. Abbot Gueranger speaks of this as the Spiritual Integration. In His Passion, our Savior's divinity was almost totally eclipsed, so great was His suffering. Thus, the wounds He endured hid both His divinity and His humanity. For this reason, we veil with the somber purple cloth during Passiontide. This is a wonderful custom and very meaningful. We lose things during Lent like jubilant music, flowers, the word Alleluia. Then in Passiontide, the statues and images are draped in purple. After the Evening Mass of the Lord's

Supper on Holy Thursday, the Blessed Sacrament is reserved and adored in the Repository in the Chapel.

On Good Friday, there isn't even a Mass. This "liturgical death" of the Church reveals how Christ emptied Himself of His glory in order to save us from our sins and to teach us who we are. Also, during Lent we are asked to fast and abstain from certain foods. Veiling/covering crucifixes and statues can be seen as another form, though a visual one of "fasting/abstaining."

Please mark your calendars for our two Penance Services on Tuesday, March 23rd at 1:15 PM and at 6:45 PM. We will have about 12 priests at both services for confessions.

**MADELEINE'S MESSAGE**

This week, we celebrate the great "Apostle of Ireland" ~ Saint Patrick. Patrick baptized, confirmed, and ordained priests, and he erected schools and monasteries. Thousands came into the Church under his direction. He accomplished all these activities in less than 30 years, during which time the whole island nation of Ireland was converted. Toward the end of his life, he wrote "Confessions", in which he gives a record of his life and mission. He died on March 17, 461 of natural causes.

He is buried in Downpatrick in present-day Northern Ireland. Many stories are told in connection with Saint Patrick. The three-leaf clover was said to be used by the Sainly Bishop to explain the Trinity to the pagans, which is why it is such a common Saint Patrick's Day symbol today. Another legend has Saint Patrick driving all the snakes out of Ireland. Snakes were a popular symbol among the Irish pagans. He is certainly one of the most revered and popular Saints of the Catholic Church.

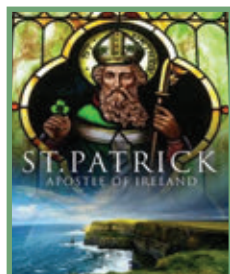
Today, Saint Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland, many dioceses throughout the English-speaking world, and he is the Patron Saint of engineers.

## KEN'S CACHE

### COVENANT AND LITURGICAL ACT.

This teaching on the Sacrament of Marriage is derived from the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults.

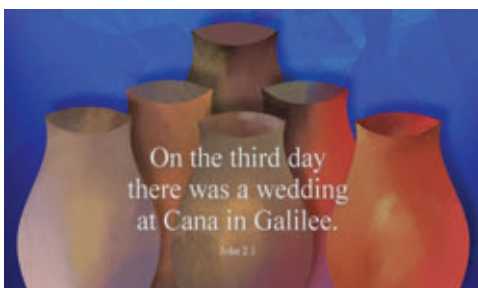
By their marriage, the couple witnesses Christ's spousal love for the Church. One of the Nuptial Blessings in the liturgical celebration of marriage refers to this in saying, "Father, you have made the union of man and wife so holy a mystery that it symbolizes the marriage of Christ and his Church." Through the liturgical celebration of marriage, husband and wife enter into a covenant which is also a Sacrament:

*The matrimonial covenant by which a man and a woman establish between themselves a partnership of the whole of life, is by its nature ordered toward the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of offspring; this covenant between baptized persons has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of sacrament. (CCC, no. 1601, citing CIC, can 1055, and Code of Canons of the Eastern Churches [CCEO], can. 776)*

The Sacrament of Marriage is a covenant, which is more than a contract. Covenant always expresses a relationship between persons. The marriage covenant refers to the relationship between the husband and wife, a permanent union of persons capable of knowing and loving each other and God. The celebration of marriage is also a liturgical act, appropriately held in a public liturgy at church. Catholics are urged to celebrate their marriage within the Eucharistic Liturgy. More on the Sacrament of Marriage next week.

## Calling all Saint Helena Men: ***SAINT JOSEPH WANTS YOU!***

Now more than ever we need the spiritual fatherhood of Saint Joseph to help us protect marriage and the family! As Sister Lucia (of the Fatima apparitions) wrote: "The final battle between the Lord and the kingdom of Satan will be about marriage and the family." As Saint John Paul II wrote: "The patronage of Saint Joseph must be invoked as ever necessary for the Church, not only as a defense against all dangers, but also, and indeed primarily, as an impetus for her renewed commitment to evangelization in the world & to re-evangelization in those lands and nations where religion and the Christian life were formerly flourishing and are now put to a hard test." ***"Now is the time to consecrate yourself to Saint Joseph!"***

**The Saint Helena Men's Group** is going to embark upon a 33-day preparation program which is modeled after Saint Louis de Montfort's Consecration to Mary. As fathers, brothers, protectors and members of this faith community, this consecration to Saint Joseph will certainly have a positive impact upon our parish and all of the men who join us in this journey. ***The first meeting will begin on Saturday, March 27,*** and the program will culminate with a final meeting on the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker (May 1st), followed by Mass at 9:00 A.M.

Each man consecrating himself to Saint Joseph will be provided with a book [*Consecration to Saint Joseph* by Father Donald Calloway], and will be required to complete several readings and prayers each day of the 33-day period (approximately 20 minutes per day). The book also lays out several discussion questions for each weekly meeting (six meetings in total). The weekly meetings will commence at 7:00 A.M. each Saturday between March 27 and May 1. Please consider this consecration in order that Saint Joseph may hold you close, intercede on your behalf, and provide you with added strength, courage and wisdom.

**THE BROTHER HOUSE**

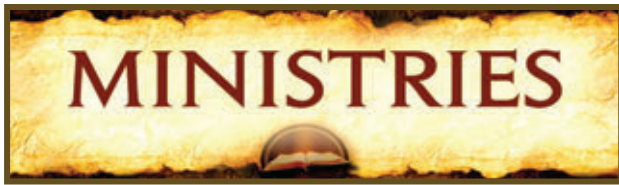
