

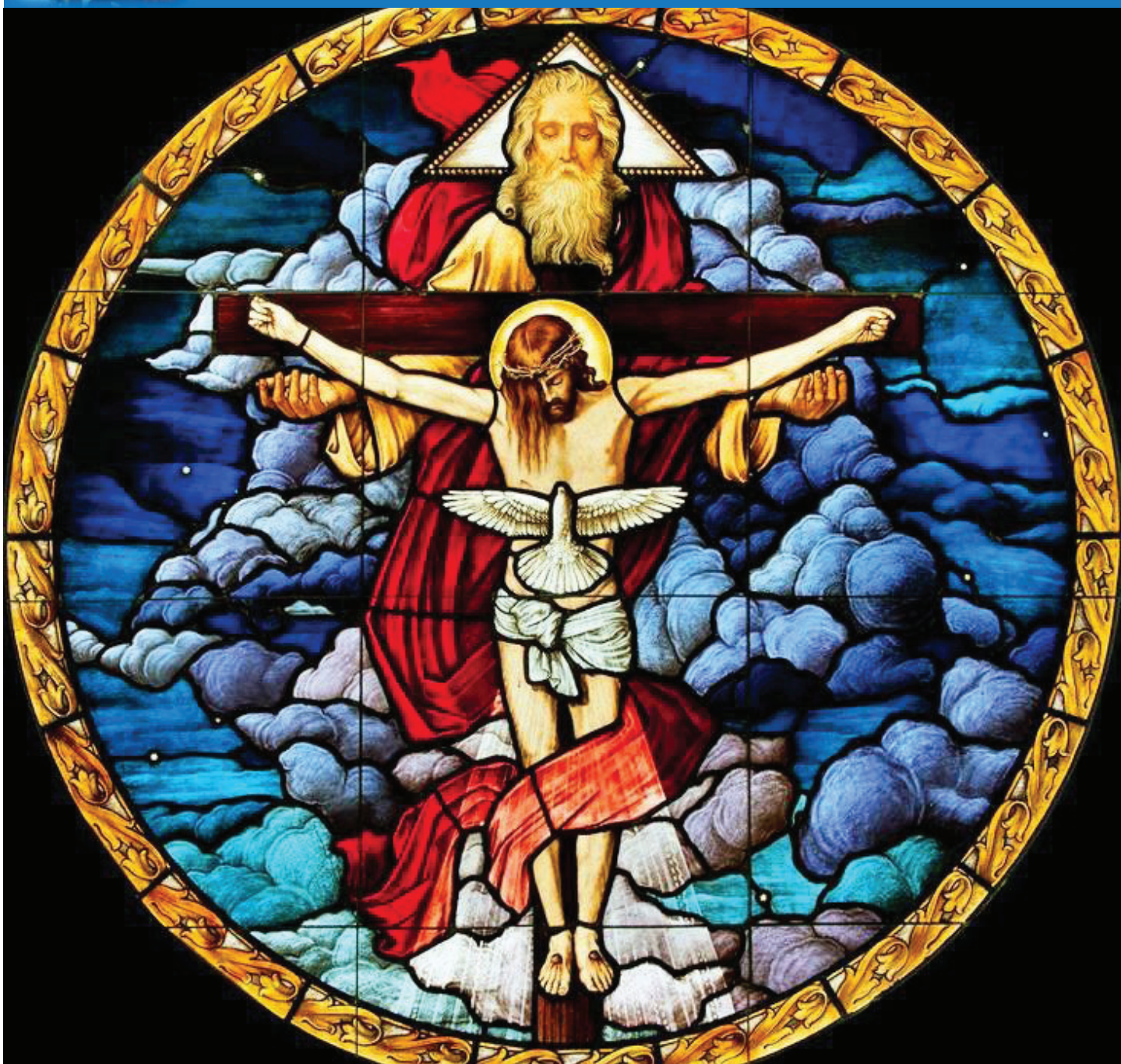

MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made with a priest at least six months *prior* to your desired wedding date. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia requires that all couples attend a Pre-Cana class. NIC NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

As I am sure you already know that according to the CDC and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, almost all of the restrictions that were put in place during the Pandemic, have been significantly reduced/eliminated. As of May 13, according to the CDC and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, if you have been fully vaccinated for COVID-19, you do not need to wear a mask in most indoor or outdoor settings. As of May 31, one does not need to maintain social distancing and the many, many sanitizing/disinfecting/cleaning procedures that were put in place during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Beginning on June 1, daily Masses will no longer be in the Church. Daily Masses will be in the Chapel. Also on June 1, the gold ropes and the blue crosses that were “marking off” the pews during the Pandemic, will no longer be there. The occupancy of all of our buildings will be permitted at 100%. As you perhaps realize our Church is never at 100% capacity except on Easter, Christmas Vigils, and Christmas Day. Our Chapel is really never at 100% capacity. As a rule, none of our Sunday Masses are more than 50 to 60% capacity. As a rule, our Chapel is 50 to 60 % capacity. If you are vaccinated, you need not wear a mask, but if you wish, you can. Those who have not been vaccinated according to the CDC/Commonwealth of Pennsylvania should wear a mask.

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia has instructed our parishes to return to normal. Shortly, we will be reintroducing the Offertory Procession as well as inviting our children to bring up food for the needy at the Offertory. We will also be inviting/asking our Greeters as well as those who take up the Sunday Collection to resume. We will also be inviting/asking people to volunteer to take up the Sunday Collection as well as being willing to be a Greeters. Hospitality is extremely important in our parish. Over the last 15 months, so many of the “niceties” that we have practiced in this parish kind of went by the wayside because of fear and the unknown. As the CDC has collected so much more information and received a lot of data we can be confident that we can move forward. And forward we must move. Many practices that we introduced during the Pandemic in relation to the Sacrament of Baptism, Sacrament of Penance, etc. will be phased out.



Please realize that we have and will continue to follow the procedures/guidelines/information for the good of the people of Saint Helena Parish. We had and we will continue to go over and beyond what needs to be done to keep our people safe. But forward we must move. You may feel that you are out of your comfort zone as we move forward, but realize how many times over the last 15 months you have moved out of your “then” comfort zone over and over again to where you now are.

KEN'S CACHE

For the next several weeks, we will review the unique
problems married couples experience that affect their
union and the support the Church offers as outlined in
the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

MIXED AND INTERFAITH MARRIAGES

The term *mixed marriage* refers to a union between
a Catholic and a baptized non-Catholic. With
appropriate permission, a Catholic can marry
a baptized non-Catholic either in a Catholic Church
or in a non-Catholic church. In the first case,
a non-Catholic minister can be present for the
ceremony just as the Catholic priest can be present
in the non-Catholic church with the permission of the
bishop.

It is clear that there are differences because of
diverse religious traditions, but these differences can
be lessened when the spouses share what they have
received from their respective traditions and learn from
each other how they fulfill their fidelity to Christ.
“But the difficulties of mixed marriages must not be
underestimated. They arise from the fact that the
separation of Christians has not yet been overcome.
The spouses risk experiencing the tragedy of Christian
disunity even in the heart of their own
home” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1634).

A marriage between a Catholic and a non-baptized
person, which is an *interfaith* marriage, and
therefore is not a sacramental marriage, can present even
greater problems for a marriage. Nevertheless, the very
differences regarding faith can be enriching for both
spouses and through God’s grace, can lead them closer
to Him.

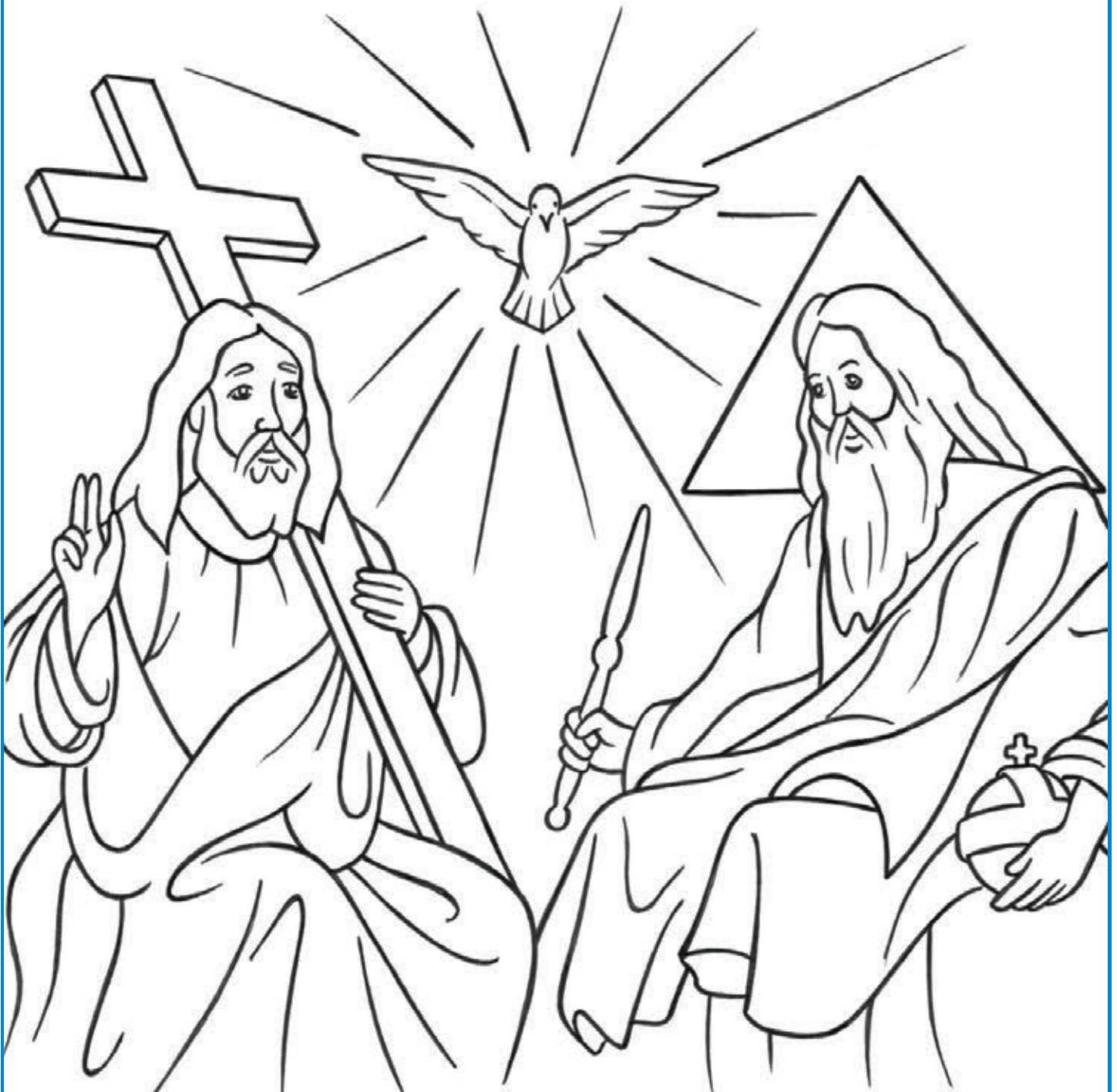

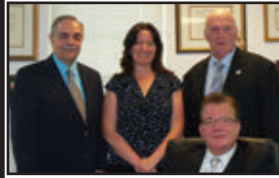
