NIC NOTES

DEAR PARISHIONERS:

On Tuesday, March 23, we will be having two “Penance Services”. The first “Penance Service” will be at 1:15 PM and this will include our grade school children. The second “Penance Service” will be at 6:45 PM and this will include our PREP children. At the time of the writing of my NIC NOTES, there are 14 priest scheduled for 1:15 PM and 12 priests scheduled for the 6:45 PM Confessions. Please mark your calendar for this wonderful opportunity to receive the Sacrament of God’s Love in the Sacrament of Penance. Once again, the Confessions are 1:15 PM and 6:45 PM. When you come into the Church and you look around, choose a Confessor and go to confession. This is a wonderful preparation for Easter.

On Thursday, March 25, we will be having two (2) Confirmation Services. One will be at 2 PM and the other will be at 4 PM. There are 98 children who will be confirmed by Bishop Deliman. Due to our protocol at this time the only ones who are permitted to come to the Confirmation are the children being confirmed, his/her parents, and the sponsor. I would ask you to hold these children in prayer as they receive the Holy Spirit in a special way in the wonderful Sacrament of Confirmation. Ask Almighty God to bless the children being confirmed as well as their families and our parish. On this Confirmation Day, as every time we have Mass or Service in the Church, we will do a thorough sanitizing and disinfecting of the Church.

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday. We will be distributing Palm at all of the Masses that weekend. I also ask that you take note of our Holy Week Services. On Holy Thursday we will have the Mass of the Lord’s Supper at 7 PM in the Church with the Procession to the Repository which will be in the Chapel. The Chapel will remain open till 10 PM. On Good Friday our Service with Reception of Holy Communion will take place at 1 PM in the Church. On Holy Saturday there will be the blessing of the Easter Foods at 10:30 AM in the Church. The Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday will be at 7 PM in the Church. Our Easter Sunday Mass Schedule will be 7:30 AM, 9 AM, and 11 AM. We will also have the Empress Room as well as the Narthex readied for all the Masses that day with lots of extra chairs, if the Church is full or you would feel more comfortable sitting in another area. You can simply place the chairs where you want to have them or in family clusters.

As you remember from last year, Holy Week and Easter were very different to say the very least. The Churches were closed to in-person Worship. However, this year will be very much different with the many protocols we have in place so that we can worship Almighty God through His Sacred Liturgies SAFELY.

THE SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

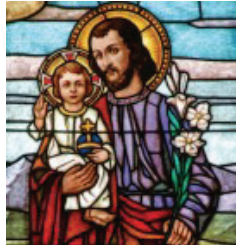

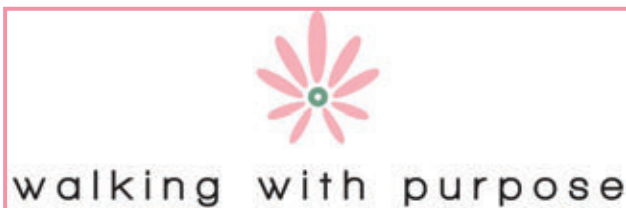

THE CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE.

This teaching on the Sacrament of Marriage is derived from the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults, namely, the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Part 3: Article 7 section II as it appears below.

According to the Latin Tradition, the spouses as ministers of Christ's grace, mutually confer upon each other the Sacrament of Matrimony by expressing their consent before the Church. In the Traditions of the Eastern Churches, the priest (bishops or presbyters) are witnesses to the mutual consent given by the spouses, but for the validity of the sacrament their blessing is also necessary.

In the Latin Church, the free consent of the couple is at the heart of the marriage celebration. By Church law, when a Catholic marries, the couple must exchange this consent in the presence of the Church's minister, two witnesses, and the congregation. The priest or deacon calls forth this consent, but the marriage itself takes place through the public consent of the couple. The priest or deacon invites the couple to do so in these words: "Since it is your intention to enter into marriage, join your right hands and declare your consent before God and His Church." There are various formulas for this consent. One that may be used is as follows: "I [Name], take you, [Name], to be my [wife/husband]. I promise to be true to you in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health. I will love you and honor you all the days of my life." In the Eastern Churches, the Sacrament is conferred by the blessing of the priest after receiving the couple's consent.

The consent is further symbolized in the Latin Church by the blessing and exchange of rings with the words: "Take this ring as a sign of my love and fidelity, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

We will have more on the Sacrament of Marriage after we pause for the Easter Celebration.

Calling all Saint Helena Men: **SAINT JOSEPH WANTS YOU!**

Now more than ever we need the spiritual fatherhood of Saint Joseph to help us protect marriage and the family! As Sister Lucia (of the Fatima apparitions) wrote: "The final battle between the Lord and the kingdom of Satan will be about marriage and the family." As Saint John Paul II wrote: "The patronage of Saint Joseph must be invoked as ever necessary for the Church, not only as a defense against all dangers, but also, and indeed primarily, as an impetus for her renewed commitment to evangelization in the world & to re-evangelization in those lands and nations where religion and the Christian life were formerly flourishing and are now put to a hard test." **"Now is the time to consecrate yourself to Saint Joseph!"**

The Saint Helena Men's Group is going to embark upon a 33-day preparation program which is modeled after Saint Louis de Montfort's Consecration to Mary. As fathers, brothers, protectors and members of this faith community, this consecration to Saint Joseph will certainly have a positive impact upon our parish and all of the men who join us in this journey. **The first meeting will begin on Saturday, March 27,** and the program will culminate with a final meeting on the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker (May 1st), followed by Mass at 9:00 A.M.

Each man consecrating himself to Saint Joseph will be provided with a book [*Consecration to Saint Joseph* by Father Donald Calloway], and will be required to complete several readings and prayers each day of the 33-day period (approximately 20 minutes per day). The book also lays out several discussion questions for each weekly meeting (six meetings in total). The weekly meetings will commence at 7:00 A.M. each Saturday between March 27 and May 1. Please consider this consecration in order that Saint Joseph may hold you close, intercede on your behalf, and provide you with added strength, courage and wisdom.

THE BROTHER HOUSE

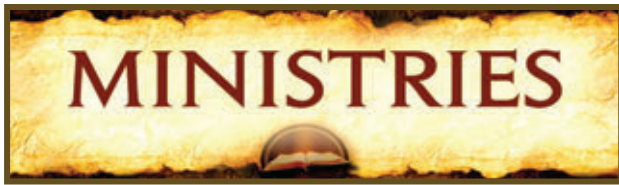

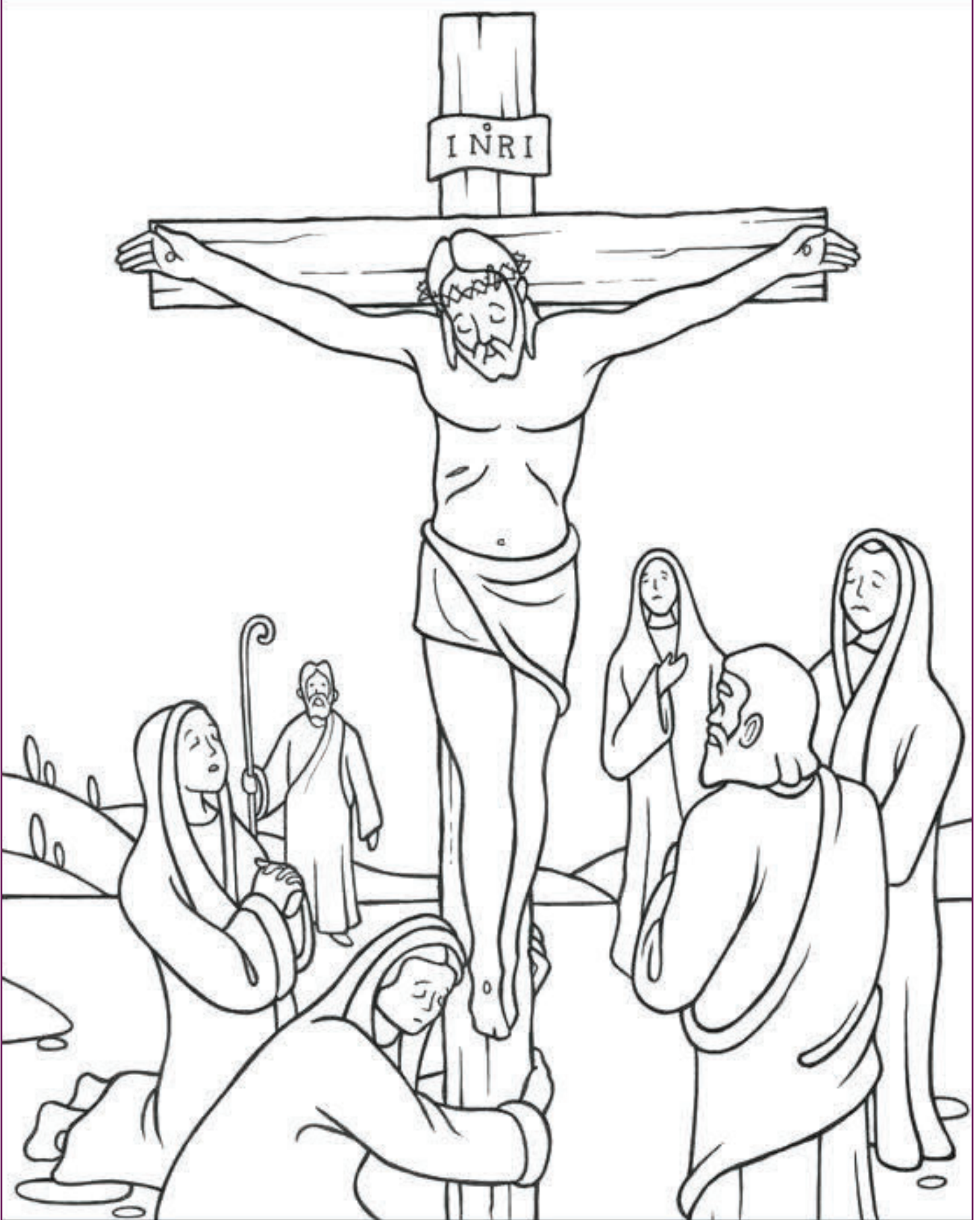

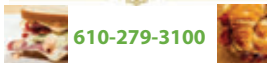
