## NIC NOTES

### DEAR PARISHIONERS:

We are now entering the most solemn time of the Liturgical Year. It is a time when it is extremely beneficial to us to unite ourselves to the saving mysteries of our redemption through our active participation in the Liturgies of this most Holy Week. Holy Week is a wonderful time for all of us to make a “mini-retreat” right here at our parish by participating in our Holy Week Liturgies.

Palm Sunday is the celebration of Christ entering Jerusalem triumphantly and how He was hailed Messiah as they laid palm branches before Him. The Passion is read at all the Palm Sunday Masses. The Passion “sets the scene” for what will happen.

Holy Thursday is the day we celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Orders at the Cathedral Basilica of Ss. Peter & Paul. The priests of the Archdiocese gather around their Ordinary, Archbishop Perez, and renew their Ordination Promises. This is at 10:00 AM at the Cathedral. On Holy Thursday evening at 7:00 PM, we will celebrate the Lord’s Supper with the Procession to the Repository in the Chapel for Adoration till 10:00 PM. This evening Mass celebrates the wonderful Sacrament of the Eucharist; the great gift of Jesus to us, His very Self. The Washing of Feet (this rite is omitted this year due to the Pandemic) reminds us to be of service and to perform acts of charity in imitation of Jesus. The Procession to the Repository in the Chapel and the Stripping of the Altar remind us of Christ’s betrayal in the garden and His imprisonment after the Last Supper.

Our Good Friday Service is at 1:00 PM. This is not a Mass; rather, it is a Liturgy of the Word, Veneration of the Cross, and reception of Holy Communion Service. Today, the Liturgy of the Word incorporates the Passion of Saint John as well as two other readings. We are focused on Christ’s immense love for us in His accepting the Cross. We then venerate the Cross. This is traditionally done by a genuflection to the Cross, held by altar servers and kissing it. Kissing the Cross is omitted this year. After the Veneration of the Cross we receive Holy Communion and then depart the Church in silence.

Holy Saturday evening we celebrate the “Mother of All Vigils” namely the Easter Vigil. This will begin at 7:00 PM. The first part of the Mass is a *Service of Light* with the singing of the *Exultet* and the *Gloria*, followed by an extended the Liturgy of the Word that incorporates several extra readings and responsorial psalms.

This is followed by the Celebration of Sacraments—Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, when there are Catechumens. Following this is the Liturgy of the Eucharist. It is truly a beautiful and meaningful Liturgy. It is longer than a normal Sunday Mass. The Easter Vigil is the first and foremost Celebration of Easter

Easter Sunday (7:30 AM, 9:00 AM, 11:00 AM) is the celebration of Christ’s Victory over Death. It is the triumph of good over evil, life over death, Christ over Satan and sin. It is the Feast of the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

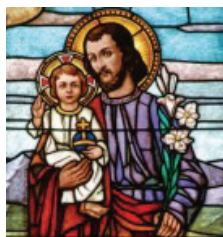

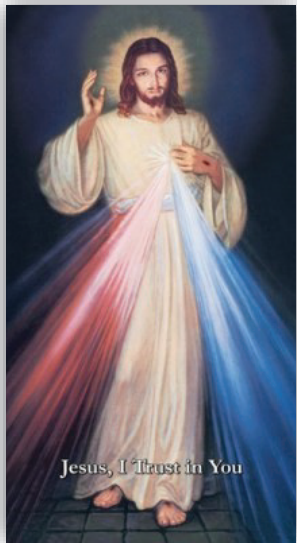

death of Saint John Paul II. Both in Poland as Archbishop of Krakow and then in Rome as Pope, he vigorously encouraged devotion to the Divine Mercy and firmly established its celebration on the Second Sunday of Easter, based on the revelations given to Saint Faustina.

## Calling all Saint Helena Men: **SAINT JOSEPH WANTS YOU!**

Now more than ever we need the spiritual fatherhood of Saint Joseph to help us protect marriage and the family! As Sister Lucia (of the Fatima apparitions) wrote: "The final battle between the Lord and the kingdom of Satan will be about marriage and the family." As Saint John Paul II wrote: "The patronage of Saint Joseph must be invoked as ever necessary for the Church, not only as a defense against all dangers, but also, and indeed primarily, as an impetus for her renewed commitment to evangelization in the world & to re-evangelization in those lands and nations where religion and the Christian life were formerly flourishing and are now put to a hard test." ***"Now is the time to consecrate yourself to Saint Joseph!"***

**The Saint Helena Men's Group** is going to embark upon a 33-day preparation program which is modeled after Saint Louis de Montfort's Consecration to Mary. As fathers, brothers, protectors and members of this faith community, this consecration to Saint Joseph will certainly have a positive impact upon our parish and all of the men who join us in this journey. ***The first meeting will begin on Saturday, March 27,*** and the program will culminate with a final meeting on the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker (May 1st), followed by Mass at 9:00 A.M.

Each man consecrating himself to Saint Joseph will be provided with a book [*Consecration to Saint Joseph* by Father Donald Calloway], and will be required to complete several readings and prayers each day of the 33-day period (approximately 20 minutes per day). The book also lays out several discussion questions for each weekly meeting (six meetings in total). The weekly meetings will commence at 7:00 A.M. each Saturday between March 27 and May 1. Please consider this consecration in order that Saint Joseph may hold you close, intercede on your behalf, and provide you with added strength, courage and wisdom.

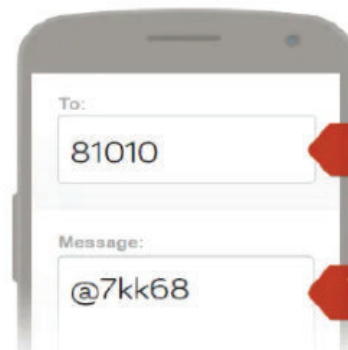

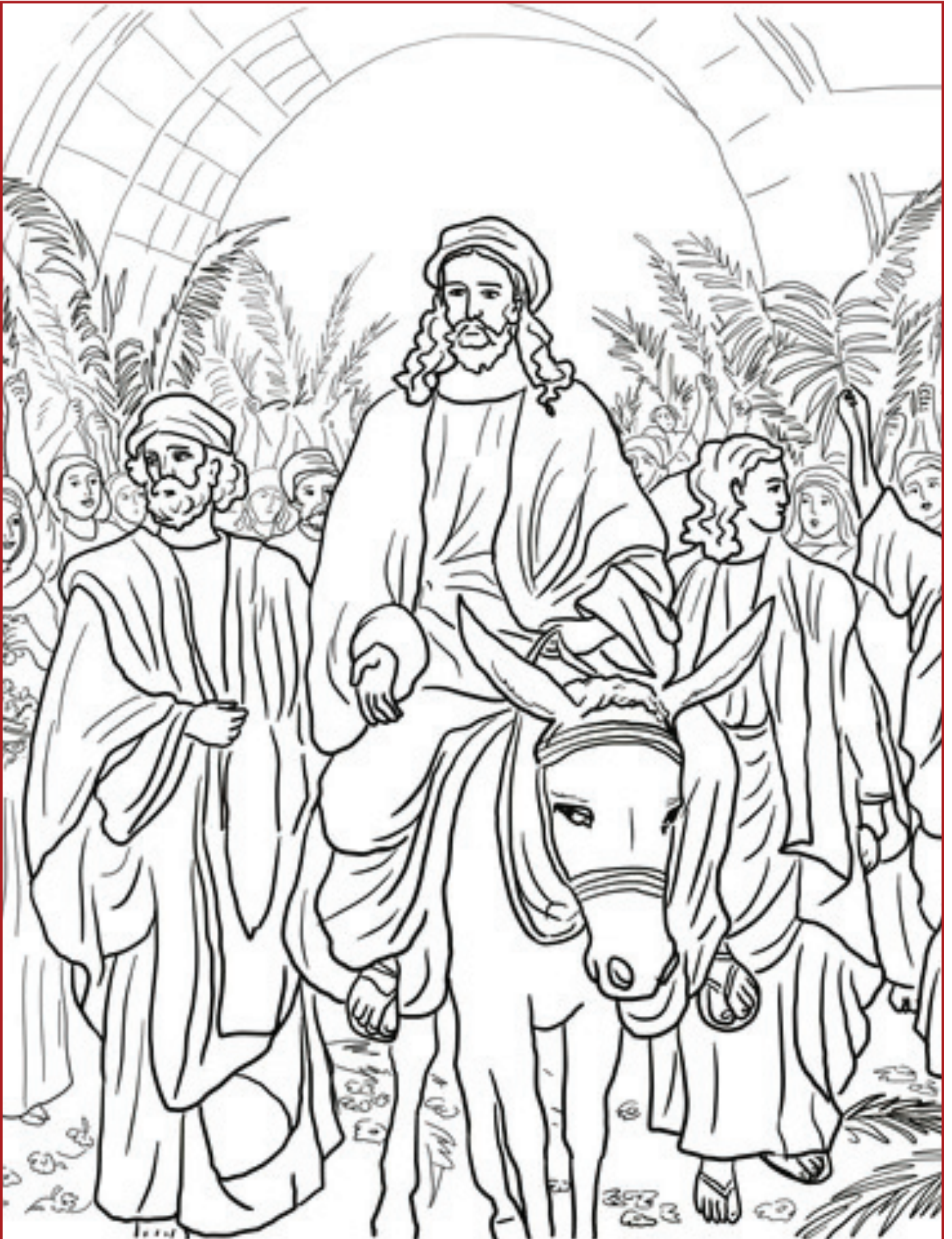

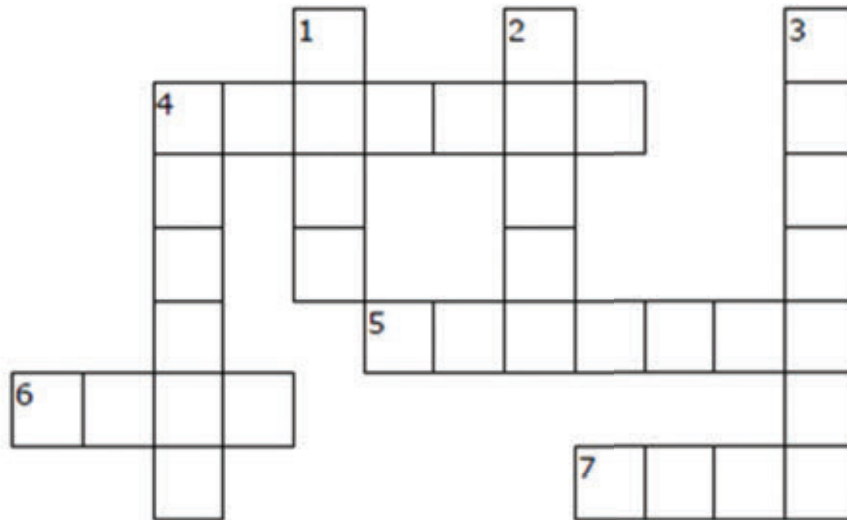
