Dear Parishioners,

We had a wonderful Vacation Bible School the week of August 9. The children who were able to participate in the week long Vacation Bible School had a wonderful time while learning even more about our faith. Their sessions included: learning religious songs and dancing to them, making religious “delicacies” (crafts) that were edible. They also made arts and crafts of a religious nature including coloring, and other fun activities as they were deepening and learning more about their Faith. They also engaged in physical activities with the religious “flair” to them. I was able to visit the classrooms and observe the children on several occasions. It was just so wonderful to see them enjoying themselves and learning about our Faith. The week of Vacation Bible School concluded with a Special Liturgy led by Deacon Ken. This was followed by refreshments for the participants and their parents. I want to make a special “thank you, thank you, thank you” to Kurt Zampier and to the many adult and teen volunteers. If it wasn’t for them, we would not have been able to sponsor this great event. I’m already looking forward to seeing the children come together next year for Vacation Bible School.

Our parish picnic, in honor of our heavenly Patroness, the Saint Helena was scheduled to take place on her Feast Day, August 18. However, due to the inclement weather that afternoon and evening, the picnic has been rescheduled for **NEXT TUESDAY EVENING, AUGUST 24 FROM 6 TO 8:30 PM.** The picnic will be held in the back parking lot/grounds. Please use the parking lot in front of the Education Center and enter through main doors. Signs will be visible to guide you to the picnic.

This weekend, August 21st and 22nd, we are celebrating the Mass of our Patron, Saint Helena at all of the Weekend Masses. It is always a wonderful time in the life of the parish to celebrate their patron. In a nutshell, Constantius (father of Constantine) divorced his wife, Helena, to advance his personal career. Eventually, Saint Helena became the Empress of the Roman Empire while her son, Constantine was the Emperor. It was not until Constantine reigned as Emperor that he brought his mother back from banishment to become the Empress. Saint Helena, who in her old age, went to the Holy Land in search of the Holy Places and she found them. She also brought back the Cross of the Crucified Jesus to Rome. She is the Statue at the very top of the Reredos —in the Church — (holding the Cross). In the Narthex, she is depicted in the Rose Window (large round window) as well as in the two large Murals of the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy on the walls flanking the central door (she is in the center of each of the murals).

May God, through the intercession of Saint Helena, bless us!

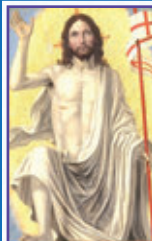

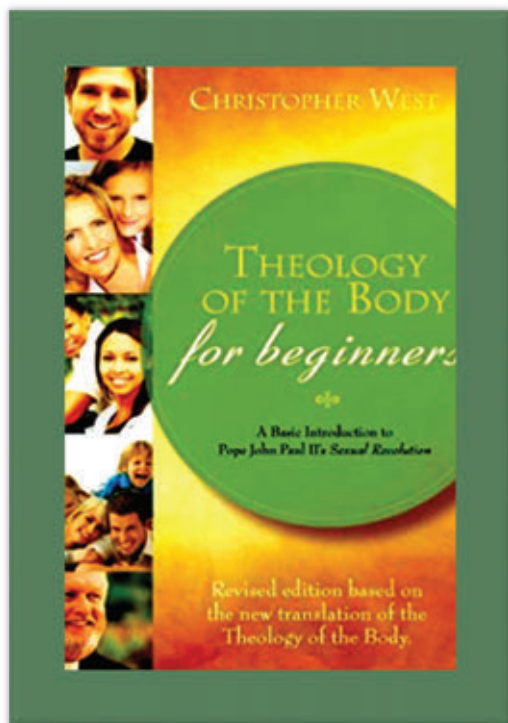

SAINT **H**ELENA, who upon opening your mind and heart to the light of the Gospel and upon finding the Wood of the Cross was converted into the model of all the Christian virtues, help us to break the attachments of sin,

KEN'S CACHE

This week, we review a twelfth century Saint whose Feast Day is August twentieth. His name is Bernard, Abbot of Clairvaux.

Bernard's parents were Tescelin de Fontaine, lord of Fontaine-lès-Dijon, and Alèthe de Montbard both members of the highest nobility of Burgundy. Bernard was the third of seven children, six of whom were sons. Aged nine, he was sent to a school at Châtillon-sur-Seine run by the secular canons of Saint-Vorles. Bernard had an interest in literature and rhetoric. He had a special devotion to the Virgin Mary, and he later wrote several works about the Queen of Heaven.

Bernard emphasized the value of a personally held Faith, with the life of Christ as a model and with a new emphasis on the Virgin Mary. In opposition to the rational approach to divine understanding used by the scholastics, Bernard preached an immediate Faith, of which the intercessor was the Virgin Mary.

Bernard was nineteen years old when his mother died. During his youth, he did not escape trying temptations. Around this time he gave much thought to living a life of solitude and prayer.

In 1098, a group led by Robert of Molesme had founded Cîteaux Abbey, near Dijon, with the purpose of living literally according to the Rule of Saint Benedict. After his mother died, Bernard decided to go to Cîteaux. In 1113, he and thirty other young noblemen of Burgundy sought admission into the new monastery. Bernard's example was so convincing that scores followed him into the monastic life, many from his own family.
