Did You Know? As Catholics, it is important to be informed about our faith and, when a situation arises, to be able to speak out in truth. It is for this reason that we occasionally present some Did You Know? columns about pro-life issues here. **There is a direct link between contraceptives & abortion. Please see below these little known facts:**

Contraception – Also known as Birth Control, is a refusal to be open to life by means of pills, devices or other willful acts that prevent the egg and sperm from uniting. Since contraception goes against the church definition of married love which is unitive (love-giving) and procreative (life-giving), it is considered a grave sin.

Hormonal Contraceptive – A type of contraception ie., The Pill, IUD, The Shot, that use artificial hormones to prevent newly formed human persons from implanting on the uterus thus resulting in spontaneous abortions. (The medical term for this contraceptive is *abortifacient*). This occurs before the mother even knows she is even pregnant.

Chemical Abortion - An abortion that is caused by taking a pill known as RU 486. It blocks progesterone, a hormone essential to the development of a pregnancy, and thereby prevents an existing pregnancy from progressing.

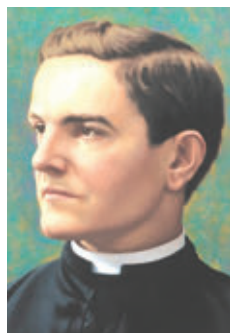

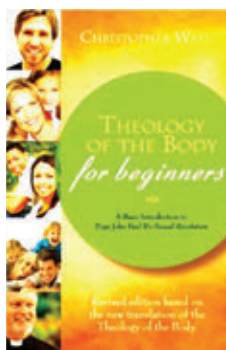

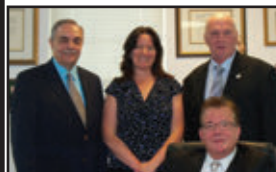
