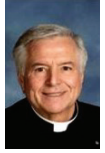

Our *Annual Forty Hours Devotions* begins this Sunday, October 24, with the 11 AM Mass. Forty Hours Devotions are always a very special time in the life of a Parish. The Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on our altar in the Church immediately after Holy Communion. We encourage and welcome our parishioners to make visits to the Most Blessed Sacrament throughout the day.

*Evening Prayer and Benediction* will be held at 7 PM in the Church on Sunday, Oct. 24, Monday, Oct. 25 and Tuesday, Oct. 26. Our *Guest homilist* will be *Father Lawrence Kozak*.

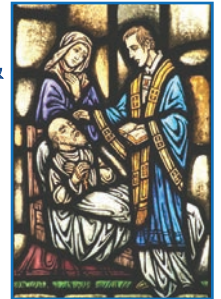

**KEN'S CACHE**

Beginning on November 28<sup>th</sup> and for the following 3 Sunday evenings, we will be celebrating Evening Prayer with Exposition and Benediction in the Chapel. As of this date, we do not need to wear a mask or practice social distancing unless one prefers to do so. We will also be virtually streaming the celebration.

Evening Prayer is one of several prayers or hours prayed universally by the Catholic Church each day. They are known as the Liturgy of the Hours, one of the two Liturgies of the Church. The other being the Liturgy of the Eucharist. This liturgy is unique in that it incorporates the Psalms as the primary biblical element during the celebration. In using the Psalms, we experience the close relationship of God to His people and His love, compassion and forgiveness of a people who continue to stray from his teaching. It also illustrates the consequences of losing that relationship by turning away from his presence.

We strongly encourage you to attend these 4 sessions, which last approximately 30 minutes each Sunday evening beginning at 7 pm. It is a blessed way to end a weekend and begin a new week experiencing our Lord is a very encouraging way.
