**KEN’S CACHE**

**FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING**

As we celebrate the last Sunday of the Year, the Feast of Christ the King, we are forced to focus on the reality of the crisis in our society today. Hopefully, by examining spiritually the attributes of Jesus’ actions, we can pursue the great commandment of loving others as we love ourselves.

In the story of the arrest, trial, and crucifixion of Jesus, we do not have a rascally, villainous cast of characters. We have ordinary soldiers, policemen, officials, priests, magistrates, and citizens - all doing what soldiers, police, officials, priests, and zealous citizens do every day. It is the usual "morality play," with a suspected criminal, arresting officers, prosecutors, a trial, and sentencing. With the exception of Jesus, none of the actors appear to be sterling characters. They are ordinary human beings, replete with a fair measure of hypocrisy and callousness. But each carries out with fidelity the role that society has assigned to him or her.

The fundamental reason why Jesus had to die makes the question of responsibility for his assassination pointless. Every society, Jewish or Gentile, that is founded on money, power, and law, condemns him. He puts people first, making economics and politics less important than men and women. In contrast, society, even when it says the opposite, deceiving others as well as itself, considers individuals simply as a means.
