We will be offering Lenten Activities/Services, for example, Stations of the Cross and Benediction, Small Groups (in person and virtual), etc. Please take note of the Constant Contact this week and next.

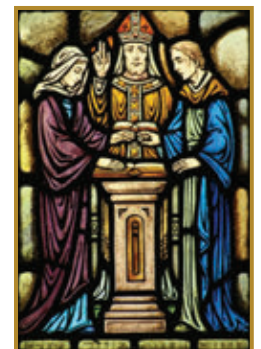

## + ASH WEDNESDAY + A BIT DIFFERENT THIS YEAR

With respect to the spirituality of receiving ashes, the Church offers some useful pointers. Paragraph 125 of the Directory for Popular Piety says:

"The act of putting on ashes symbolizes fragility and mortality, and the need to be redeemed by the mercy of God. Far from being a merely external act, the Church has retained the use of ashes to symbolize that attitude of internal penance to which all the baptized are called during Lent. The faithful who come to receive ashes should be assisted in perceiving the implicit internal significance of this act, which disposes them towards conversion and renewed Easter commitment."

While in most English speaking countries the custom of imposing ashes in the form of a cross on one's forehead has been the norm, in many European countries including Italy, the ashes have customarily been sprinkled on the crown of the head of the faithful.

In an effort to minimize physical contact because of the pandemic and in following the recent directives of the Holy See regarding the imposition of ashes, Saint Helena parish will adopt the European custom of imposing ashes on the crown of each person's head and **NOT** by tracing the cross on each person's forehead.

Additionally, the Holy See has asked that the verbal formula for the rite be proclaimed only once before the distribution of ashes begins. Each person will approach the priest or other minister and bow his/her head as the ashes are silently imposed. The person will then return to his seat for the remainder of the Mass or Service.

While the method by which we will distribute ashes this year will be a bit different, you are reminded that none of their significance is lost because of the adaptation of this European custom.

## KEN'S CACHE

### THE SETTLING OF THE "ROMAN QUESTION"

Temporal power returned to the Vatican on February 11th. For fifty-nine years, Popes had been so-called "prisoners of the Vatican." Not one Pope had stepped outside the borders of the Vatican over all those years in protest over Italy's annexation of the Papal States in 1870. The protest had become rather anachronistic, and everyone with sense wanted to settle the dispute, including Benito Mussolini, Italy's Fascist leader and then Prime Minister.

The possibility of negotiations was broached in 1927, and proceeded with such speed that the Pope, Pius XI, thought he was being rushed into an agreement. He preferred a slower pace and, not prevailing there, proposed completing the negotiations, but leaving the actual signing to his Papal Successor – to which his Secretary of State, Cardinal Pietro Gasparri, is said to have protested, "No, no, Your Holiness! Now or never!" The Pope acceded, and on February 7, 1929, Cardinal Gasparri called together heads of the diplomatic community and officially announced that the "Roman Question," as the issue had come to be called had been successfully resolved.

The terms of the agreement were ratified four days later as the "Lateran Concordat" and by any historical reassessment they were as much as the Vatican realistically could hope for under the circumstances. The Italian State renounced all claim to Vatican territory in Rome, and the Vatican became a city-state of 108.7 acres – not a large area, but sufficiently large to insure temporal independence, while protecting political and spiritual integrity for its head, the Pope.

In addition, the Vatican received 1,750 million lire (\$100 million) and specified the rights of Italy itself in the realm of education and over mores (moral practices) controlled by law.

Roman Catholicism was declared the state religion, and the Church assumed sweeping controls over Italian life that would last until the signing of a new concordat in 1984, under Saint John Paul II. Pius XI was to reign for another ten years, convinced that he had "given Italy back to God, and God back to Italy."
