NIC NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

Thus far with all planning and the implementations of the procedures that we have put in place, the academic school year for the children of Saint Helena School is running very smoothly. The cleaning/sanitizing in the Education Center is in high gear and is being done regularly. The Task Force meets regularly and goes over the CDC directives, Montgomery County directives and recommendations, and Archdiocesan Office of Education directives and make sure they are being implemented properly. They also looked at events that are upcoming and study ways that they can make everything safe.

Our PREP program has begun and they just had their second in-person religious education class. On the first night of PREP we had 55 new registrations 22 of which were for Level I, mind you we had a Registration Night prior to these classes for Level I as well as new children in various Levels to our religious formation. We were “a little overwhelmed “especially with the number of new registrations in Level I. We were prepared for 10, but not 22. However, Mrs. Fitzgerald and the Level I teachers came up with a solution that we know will work and that will keep our children safe.

As the pastor of Saint Helena Church, nothing is more important to me than the safety and well-being of all our parishioners, especially our children. We take extra, extra precautions and do deep cleaning of our Pre-K classes as well as the classrooms in the Education Center. Our children who attend St. Helena School and our Saint Helena PREP are very precious to us and it is our priority to keep them safe and healthy when they are with us. We also make it a point to make sure that our Faculty, Staff, and Volunteers are also safe.

In several weeks we will be having a Ministry Weekend that will be held after all of the Masses on Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning. I'm very grateful for this Outreach Ministry who will be speaking and “working” at the Ministry Tables. If the weather is good, the Ministry tables and light refreshments will be under the bell tower outdoors. If the weather is “iffy”, the Ministry tables will be set up in the Narthex and light refreshments will be under the bell tower indoors. In conjunction with Time and Talent, we will be having our Revitalization Collection/Census. As always I'm very grateful for the generosity of our parishioners.

Let us begin to encourage our fellow families/friends/parishioners who are in good health to return to in person Worship. Being able to participate actively with the reception of Holy Communion is irreplaceable. We have extra folding chairs in the Narthex. You can take them and place them anywhere in the narthex or in the Nave (the Body of the Church).

You can wear a mask, if you desire or you don't have to wear a mask. But let us begin to encourage others to come to in person worship.

education to children from Level 1 thru Level 7.

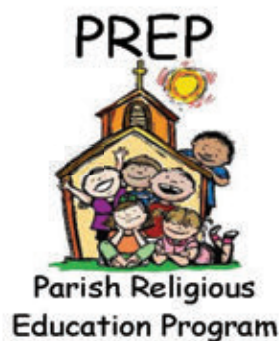
PREP classes are Tuesdays 6:30 - 8:00 PM. Please see your copy of the PREP calendar sent home in the red folder.
