

give all priests Thy spirit of humility;


Jesus, Poor and Worn out for souls,

Blood of Christ, Pledge of Eternal Life, *save us.*


Blood of Christ, Freeing Souls from purgatory, *save us.*





Concluding Doxology - after 5 decades on last 3 beads:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy
on us and on the whole world.

Prayer to the Holy Angels


